Transition Service Activities for Middle School Students:

Things to remember when completing this section of the IEP:

- The IEP goal should be listed under all three areas
- It is recommended that there be 3-5 activities under each area in addition to the IEP goal
- Always mark "YES" for IEP goal
- Be general in the service activity- do not write them like IEP goals

Postsecondary Education Activities:

- Use agenda book to maintain assignments
- Take notes independently
- Complete large projects using a timeline
- Meet with guidance counselor in small groups to complete course selection sheet
- Complete and turn in assignments on time

Employment Activities:

- Teacher will provide account and login information to student in order to access Keys2Work (or ConnectEdu) to explore careers
- Arrive to classes on time
- Follow class schedule
- Follow building and classroom rules
- Participate in six-week career exploration class (grade 8 only)
- Maintain a career portfolio (grade 8 only)

Independent Living Activities:

- Develop life-long learning skills for physical fitness and wellness
- Improve cooking and home management skills
- Teacher will provide information on school activities and clubs available to student throughout the school year
- Read and follow recipes
- Learn computer keyboarding
